CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE

We the members of American Concrete Institute Student Chapter at FIU, and subscribing to the regulations and policies of Florida International University, establish this Constitution to govern the matters within our organization.

Article I - Name

- Section 1** The name of this organization shall be American Concrete Institute Student Chapter at FIU
- Section 2** This student chapter is affiliated with American Concrete Institute.

Article II - Purpose

- Section 1** Primary purpose of this organization is to develop, share, and disseminate the knowledge and information needed to utilize concrete to its fullest potential.

Article III - Membership

- Section 1** Membership is open to all FIU students. Membership may be terminated in case of misconduct. E-board will have power to suspend or terminate membership.

Article IV - Officers

- Section 1** The officers of this organization shall consist of:
- President (Responsible of overall planning of events. He will also maintain the Orgsync account)
 - Vice President (Responsible for the execution of events and meetings)
 - Treasurer (Responsible for maintaining the balance sheet of funds and keeping track of spendings)
 - CSO Representative (Work as a liaison between club and CSO)

Section 2 All officers must have GPA of at least 2.5.

Section 3 Term of office shall be one academic year.

Section 4 President will have power to initiate the removal process of an officer. Removal will require simple majority of E-board voting in favor of removal

Article V - Elections

Section 1 Election will be held once in a year at the beginning of summer semester.

Section 2 Special election will be held within three weeks of the vacancy being available. Election will be held in the general meeting. Special general meeting can also be called for the election purposes.

Section 3 Election will be held through secret ballot. All the members present at the meeting will be eligible to vote. There is no quorum requirement.

Article VI - Meetings

Section 1 Regular meetings of this organization shall be held monthly. Vice president shall be notifying the meeting through emails and notice board.

Section 2 There is no quorum requirement at this time. E-board may decide to have quorum requirements in future.

Article VII - Advisors

Section 1 There shall be at least one full time faculty/staff advisor at all times in the organizations.

Section 2 Advisor will oversee all the activities and events. E-board is recommended to meet the advisor once a month to keep him informed about the current and future activities.

Article VIII - Amendments

Section 1 A 2/3 majority vote in the general meeting shall be required to amend the constitution.
